



Uniform Code



Full College uniform must be worn every day unless the College communicates otherwise. Full College uniform is required on all excursions unless the excursion note specifically states other apparel is to be worn. If a student is not able to be in full College uniform, they should carry a note from their parent or carer explaining the reason.

Clothing

The College polo is to be worn each day, including for sport and PE classes. Students are required to wear the College polo shirt with black College shorts, or black tailored trousers¹. Girls have the option of wearing a black College skirt.

As the College has introduced a new polo shirt for 2021, students are welcome to continue wearing their current grey polo or white and ochre polo during the transition phase.

Shoes and Socks

Students are to wear entirely black, leather shoes or runners with laces or velcro to support and protect the toes and the top of the feet. Canvas and fabric tops are not suitable. Students are expected to wear white socks that are visible above the shoe line.



Sport Clothing

Senior School students are required to wear the College grey polo and the black College shorts for all PE lessons and when representing the College at a sporting competition. Students are encouraged to change into a fresh polo shirt after their PE classes.

Shoes for Sport

When wearing the sports uniform, students may wear joggers or runners with soles suitable for grass, not skate shoes. These shoes do not need to be black. White socks are required.

Personal Presentation

Students are expected to keep their hair clean, neat and tidy, and maintain natural hair shades. Hair that is shoulder length or longer is to be tied back. Hair accessories should be ochre, grey, black, brown or white in colour. If worn, nail polish and makeup must be discrete and only in natural shades.

Accessories

Senior students are permitted to wear a wrist watch, one small ring, one thin bracelet and one thin necklace. Piercings may have an unobtrusive stud. Hoops and sleepers are not allowed. Accessories are not to have symbols or designs that are contrary in any way to College beliefs and values.



Hat

Campus hat is a compulsory part of the College uniform.

Cool Weather options:

In cooler weather, students are permitted to wear a plain black jacket or jumper (no symbols or logos), the Year 10 jacket, or their Year 12 jersey.

¹ Plain black tailored trousers can be worn. They may be purchased from any retailer, but must not have any visible logos or graphics.
