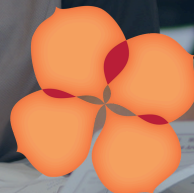

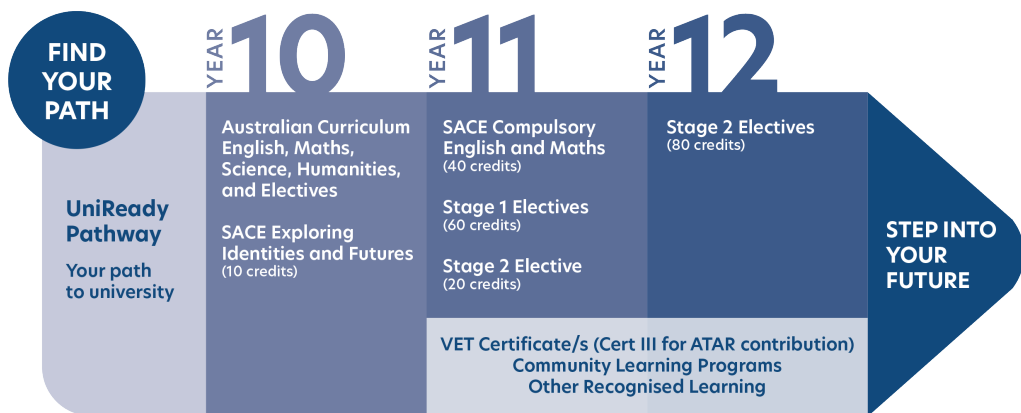

## UniReady Pathway

For students pursuing NTCET with an ATAR for direct entry to a university

This pathway is designed to prepare you for specific university courses, supporting you to meet prerequisites and to achieve the required ATAR in a traditional school model.

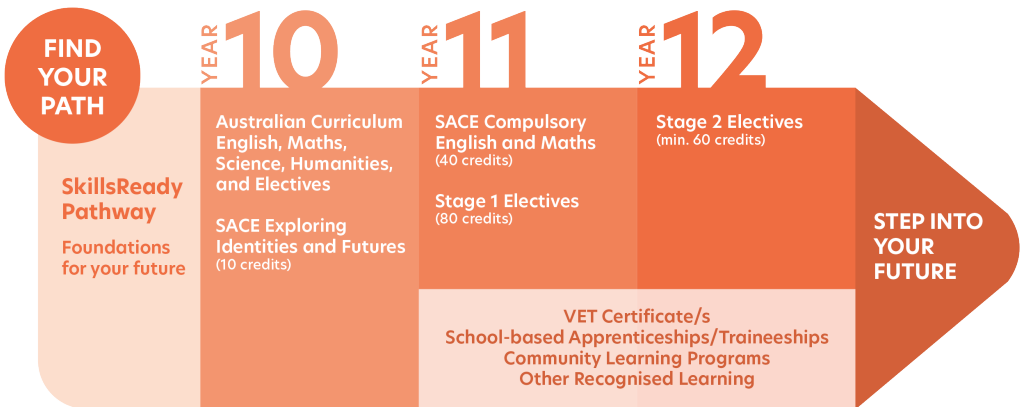


*foundations for your future*

## SkillsReady Pathway

For students pursuing NTCET with transferable skills for a variety of futures

This pathway is designed to prepare you for your future, building a range of skills in academic and vocational learning in a structured school model.

## WorkReady Pathway

For students pursuing NTCET for direct entry into work or industry

This pathway is designed to prepare you for specific workplaces or industries with the vocational skills you need in a flexible school model.



# YOUR PATTERN

Once you have chosen one of the three pathways, you need to plan to fill out your pattern (see the next page for more details about that!). While you begin this task with the compulsory EIF subject in Year 10, you have a lot of flexibility throughout your senior years.

You can fill your pattern with school-based subjects:

- Stage 1 Subjects (typically studied at Year 11)
- Stage 2 Subjects (typically studied at Year 12)

Or with vocational and community learning:

- Vocational Education and Training (VET) Courses
- School-based Apprenticeships or Traineeships (SBATs)
- Recognised Community Learning (Cadets, St Johns, Music, etc.)
- Self-directed Community Learning Interviews

All school-based subjects are offered as either semester-long or year-long subjects. Successful completion of these will give you 10 or 20 credits respectively. Other recognised learning will give you credits based on the level and time-commitment of the course.

You should plan to fill your pattern with a member of our Pathways Team to ensure you meet all the requirements of your chosen pathway.

# NTCET Pattern

This graphic summarises the requirements for attaining your NTCET.

Please note you are also required to:

- Pass EIF with a grade of C- or better
- Pass your compulsory literacy with a grade of C- or better
- Pass your compulsory numeracy with a grade of C- or better
- Pass your Stage 2 compulsory (60 credits) at C- or better

N.B. UniReady students need to complete 90 credits at Stage 2 for ATAR

As you grow, your interests and goals may shift. That's okay. Be open to change and use each experience to learn more about yourself and where you're headed.

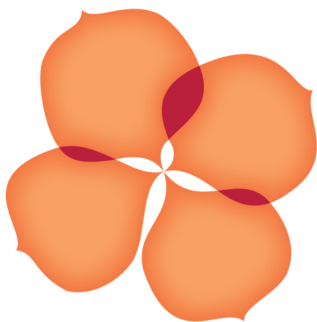
