WorkReady STUDIOS

NT Christian College's WorkReady Studios are flexible learning hubs designed to support students on WorkReady Pathways to complete their compulsory NTCET credits alongside vocational, industry, and community learning. It is possible for students on this pathway to incorporate select academic subjects at Marrara Campus.

Each Darwin-based campus will host a WorkReady Studio. Learning for these students will be supported by specialists including a literacy teacher, numeracy teacher, and co-educator.

Students will complete their literacy, numeracy, and work readiness learning in a flexible mode that works around their other learning commitments.

SUBJECTS

LITERACY

Students will complete Stage 1 Essential English in Year 11, followed by Stage 2 in Year 12. These subjects count toward the compulsory NTCET literacy requirement while preparing students with the literacy skills they need for everyday life and their vocation.

NUMERACY

Students will complete Stage 1 Essential Mathematics in Year 11, followed by Stage 2 in Year 12. These subjects count toward the compulsory NTCET numeracy requirement while extending mathematical knowledge through problem-solving and application in everyday work contexts to prepare students for a range of careers.

WORK READINESS

Students will complete Stage 1 Integrated Learning in Year 11. This flexible and individualised SACE subject gives students the ability to demonstrate competency in a variety of contexts relevant to them. This will be connected to their future vocation and help them to learn to apply the skills they have developed throughout their years of schooling.

Students will complete Stage 2 Workplace Practices in Year 12. This subject allows students to develop knowledge, skills, and understanding of the nature, type, and structure of the workplace. They consider their rights and responsibilities as workers and the future of work. This learning is all connected to their practical experience in certificates and work placements.

LEARNING MODULES

Each SACE subject in WorkReady Studios will be delivered through a series of approximately one-hour learning modules. These modules include teacher-led instruction and curated online resources, supported by co-educators. Assessments are built into the modules and carefully scaffolded to meet SACE requirements. Students will have access to a checklist showing their progress, helping them stay on track and understand what they need to complete.

CREDIT ATTAINMENT

Students will achieve 140 Credits through flexible school-based learning:

- 20 Credits in Year 10 (1EIF, 1CXD [TBC])
- 60 Credits in Year 11 (1ETE, 1MEM, 1ILN)
- 60 Credits in Year 12 (2ETE, 2MEM, 2WPC)

Students will achieve a further 30 – 60 Credits through VET.

Additional Credits can be obtained through Self-directed Community Learning Interviews and other Recognised Learning Programs.

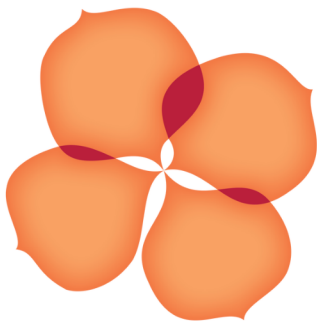
